

Brief Report 2019 of the General Meeting of NGO " League of Professional Women" and Workshop on "Analytics on Women or Developed by Women in 2019"

The general meeting of our NGO has been successfully held on the evening of December 19, 2019 in Kyiv. We combined this year's general meeting with the "Women's Analytics or developed by women in 2019", which was registered as a *local event for the global Feminist and Women's Movement Action Plan to Beijing* + 25. This future Action Plan will be considered during the 64th session of the UN Committee on Women's Rights in New York (CSW64), 9-20 March 2020, where we plan to participate.

The results of early presidential reelections and the Board of NGO "League of Professional Women" (LPW) for a new term - 5 years, ie 2020-2024, were announced during this general meeting. The majority of the LPW members had voted online with newsletters (provided by the new version of LPW Statute), the results of voting has been approved on the day of the General Meeting 19.12.19. According to the results of the voting, the Board for 2020-2024 included: **Olena Lazorenko** (President and Chairman of the Board), Coordinators - **Valentyna Lehka** and **Olga Gomilko**.

The effectiveness of the third Ukrainian Political Uzvar workshop was backed up by a blitz poll "Are you interested in continuing topics"? It results confirmed the desire of the LPW members and the Advisers to continue this topic in an interesting way of discussion.

Valentyna Lehka in her report has confirmed the high qualification of the LPW's activities, unveiled the LPW's plans for 2020 in the context of the *Global Feminist and Women's Movement Action Plan* and the First VNR of Ukraine under the Sustainable Development Goals. The special attention was paid to the ongoing preparation for the LPW's reporting to the UN Global Compact for two years (October 2017- January 2020).

The relevance of education for adults in our society is only growing, lifelong learning needs a qualified approach, appropriate legislative decisions, so for the LPW this problem remains in the circle of interests and tasks.

The blitz-presentation of Olga Herasymchuk's own achievements in craft-and decorative arts attracted a vivid interest. High artistic creativity, multifaceted work, the beauty of colors provoked a positive reaction among all those present and confirmed the thesis that work done with pleasure inspires further creativity.
